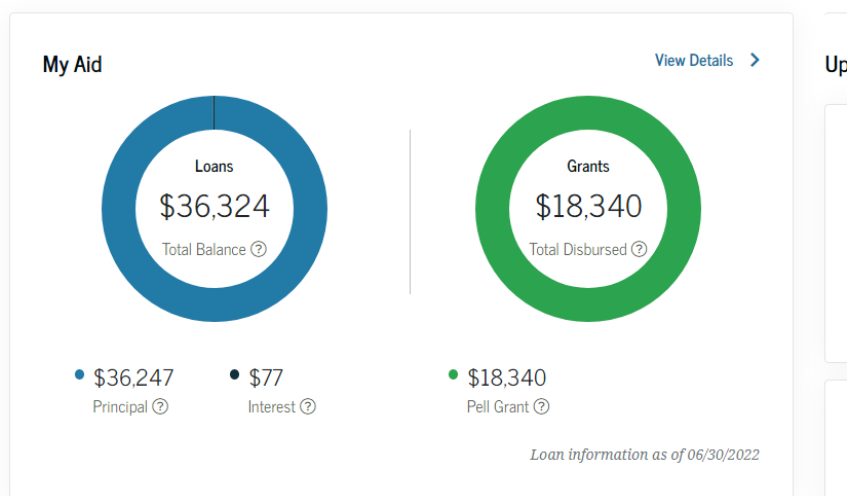

- If you click the “View Details” link at the top right it will give you a breakdown of each loan received and each Pell grant received:

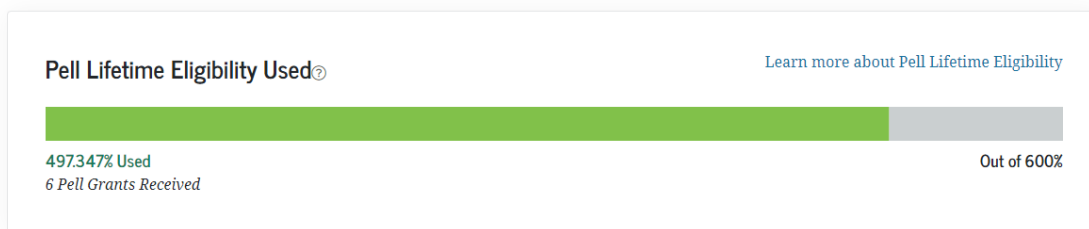
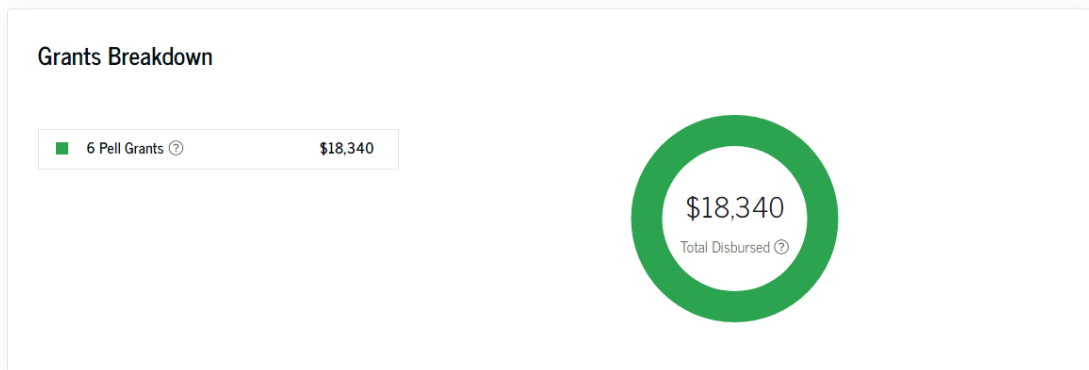
